This is a way to honor Veterans or Active Duty Service Members who at one time considered Newport their hometown or currently reside in Newport.

Any student who attended the Newport school system, even if they reside in a neighboring town, is qualified for this program.

Does not have to be currently serving, we honor anyone who has ever honorably served in the U.S. Military.

At this time the fee to sponsor a banner for Newport is \$200.00. This is for a single photograph banner and includes all costs for the banner, hardware, and any other costs. We also offer a dual photograph banner which is \$270.00 and includes everything included with a single photograph banner. This is for the 2021 banner year. Our dual photo banner is an attempt to give our clients a way of honoring someone who served in two branches of the military, or honoring two individuals on one banner. Concord for Hometown Heroes Banners is planning to store all banners during the time after Veterans Day until a couple of weeks before Memorial Day.

At this time banners hang time is controlled by the town, with a tentative agreement to hang our banners three times a year, for a seven to ten day time frame centered around Memorial Day, Independence Day, and Veterans Day. It is our sincere wish to increase this hang time, with public receptiveness to our program, this should be possible. Our desired goal is to see them hang just prior to Memorial Day to post Veterans Day. At the end of their hanging life cycle, which is expected to be 5 to 6 years or more based on the current hanging time agreed to by the Town, they will be returned to the sponsor.

We will replace any banner that fails or is vandalized in the first eighteen months of actual hang time, which is compatible with our three year policy in other towns that we operate in.

Any banner replacement after the warranty period will be \$140.00, as long as there are no major changes from the original banner. Any replacement banner will carry the same warranty as the original.

All meritorious awards must be verified before being printed on the banner.

We would like to thank you for participating in and supporting our program and we will do our best to fulfill your expectations of honoring and paying tribute to your Hometown Hero.
